Mural of historical figures dedicated at Safe and Smart

More than 50 people dedicated a 67-foot-long mural depicting figures from history yesterday on Greenmount Avenue at the Safe and Smart Center, which provides free mediation services.

Relatives of people depicted in the mural joined the ceremony, including Arun Gandhi, grandson of India social reformer Mohandas K. Gandhi; Geraldine Day, widow of Leon Day, a Baltimore Baseball Hall of Famer; and Pauline Copes-Johnson, a great-grandniece of Maryland-born abolitionist Harriet Tubman.
