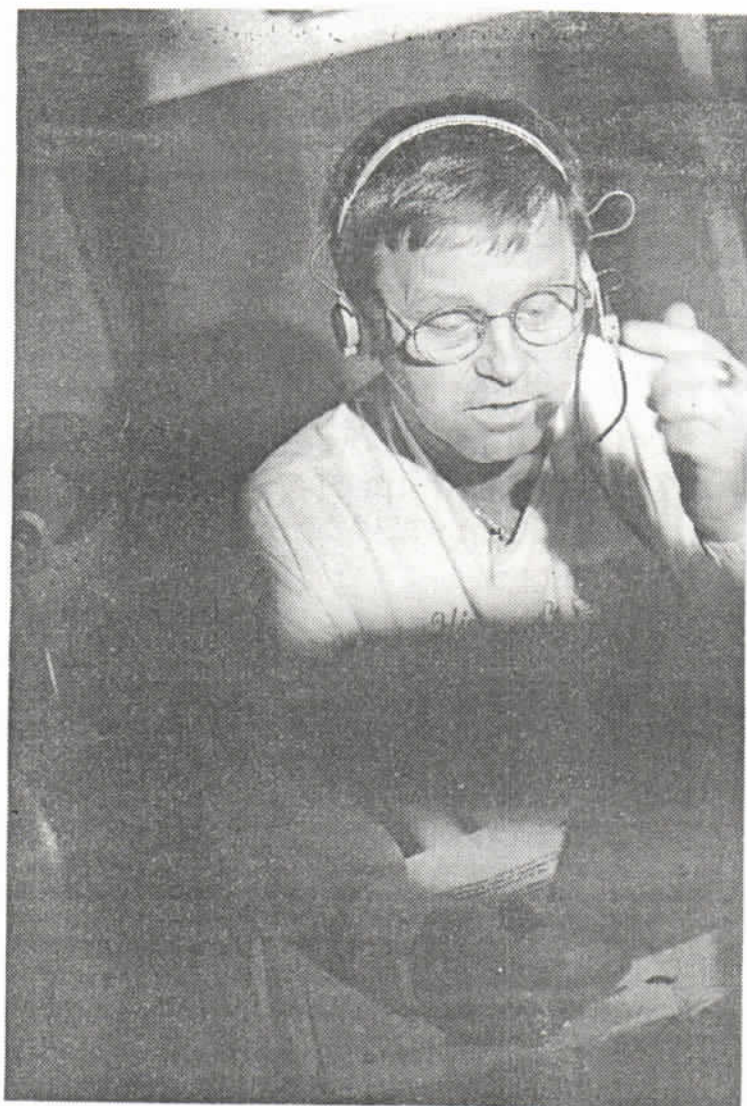

Best Radio Show

21st Century Radio
WCBM, 680-AM

It's not just a radio show. It's "an international forum for a discussion of the new paradigm." That's how husband-and-wife cohosts Dr. Bob and Zohara Hieronimus describe their hard-to-describe, nationally syndicated New Age talk show, heard here in Baltimore on WCBM, Sundays, 10 p.m. to midnight. It's a goofy, erudite mix of high weirdness and low-budget philosophy, with a fascinating cast of fringe researchers, speculators, conspiracy theorists, rock stars, and just regular folks with strange ideas. One week it's urgent supposition about one-world government, UFO cover-ups, crop circles, and tesla fields, and the next week it's *Rocky & Bullwinkle* (one of the Hieronimus' ongoing interests). But don't dismiss this as the usual lunatic-fringe freak show. Dr. Bob has a knack for snaring some "serious" establishment scientists and mainstream academics along with all the wackos, and he is a witty, thoughtful interviewer. Whether you buy this stuff or not, it's indispensable listening for anyone with an open mind and a sense of humor, or someone who needs them.
